RE: SPIDERWEBB WINS CASE AGAINST QUALITY SAFETY
QUALITY SAFETY APPEALS JUDGEMENT

Dear Valued Customers and Suppliers,

As many of you may be aware Spiderwebb WON the in our opinion malicious litigation against us brought by Quality Safety in a judgement handed down by the Honourable Judge Makume.

Quality Safety for reasons only known to them has chosen to appeal against the judgement and due to a technicality has been granted leave to appeal in the matter. We have been advised by our legal team that it is common practice for the losing side (Quality Safety in this instance) to appeal and which appeal they are legally entitled to.

It is our opinion this is just a further attempt by Quality Safety to delay the inevitable and drag the matter for as long as possible. We are also of the opinion that no other Judge will rule differently from the judgement handed down by the Honourable Judge Makume. The full judgement of Judge Makume is available on our website (www.spiderwebb.co.za) should you wish to read it. The facts remain the same, The failed harness design manufactured by Quality Safety failed during testing at our premises and during testing by Quality Safety themselves at their premises in the presence of Brian Bland the sole Director of Quality Safety. Both failures resulted in Amplats recalling all Quality Safety's harnesses in a memo titled "RECALL OF SUBSTANDARD SAFETY HARNESS " and we quote directly from the memo " **...THE TEST REVEALED A CATASTROPHIC FAILURE OF THE QUALITY HARNESS.... QUALITY SAFETY ALSO DID ACCEPT THE FAILURE....**"

It is pertinent to point out that our harness passed all the relevant testing " **THE TEST REVEALED A POSITIVE FINDING ON THE SPIDERWEBB HARNESSCONFORMING TO THE TEST REQUIREMENTS**"

In our opinion it is most unfortunate that Quality Safety has chosen to launch unfounded and malicious litigation against us to try and hide the fact that their harness design failed not just during testing by us but failed during testing by themselves instead of admitting that they experienced a failure with their design to the marketplace.
